Amazing to find such a great ethnographic item and still with the original leather protection hand sewn on, to protect the edges and reinforce. Completely handwoven in the late 19th century, they were a utilitarian object made by the girls of the tribes and used to transport whatever would fit in them, over the back of a donkey.
