The pale blue four corner spandrels are electric and stunning dyes, varied and really showcase their dying prowess as well as the large geometric leaf and tribal motifs in the corners. A fantastic tribal carpet in excellent original condition, the wool pile is medium high throughout this piece. Among the oversized carpets made in Persia, antique Bakshaish carpets are in a class by themselves. In essence, antique Bakshaish carpets adapt the style and feeling of the finest smaller village or tribal rugs to the scale of room-size pieces.
