Opens to reveal a fitted interior with original pink silk and paper lining featuring small compartments for threads etc, around a central well with an octagonal lid. The marquetry decoration is repeated on the inside of the lid, on the shaped apron and on the tapering sides below. Raised on a turned rosewood column and carved tripod legs.
