The fret pierced 'Pagoda' galleried top above two cupboard doors, each painted with romantic scenes, after Francois Boucher, the side panels with ribbon tied floral festoons, the elaborate chinoiserie decorated black lacquer interior fitted with an arrangement of drawers and open shelves and trellis pierced sliding doors, the blind fret carved stand raised on four chamfered square legs.
