An 18th-century Meissen sugar bowl, adorned with polychrome decoration, featuring garlands of flowers and foliage. The intricate floral motifs are finely painted in vibrant enamels, encased within gilt cartouches. The piece is complemented by an early 20th-century gold plated .800 silver cover embellished with a moulded rose knob, encircled by a delicate gadrooned border, and accompanied by a matching saucer. Saucer and lid gold plated silver hallmarked for Vienna, 1930's, silver purity 800 (toucan bird). Porcelain bowl marked with the Meissen Marcolini period blue crossed swords mark with asterisk below the crosspieces, dating it to 1773-1814. 140 g total weight 93.51 g silver weight cup - 4.5 cm tall, 6 cm top diameter, 2.7 cm bottom diameter bowl - 1 cm tall, 9 cm diameter cover - 2.5 cm tall, 6.5 cm diameter Excellent antique condition. Wear to gild; small indentation to porcelain. Delivery is included in the price.
