Description

Early 18th century walnut barometer, the arched engraved brass register flanked by free-standing columns and surmounted by a moulded cornice and cresting with three brass ball finials; the cross-grained column with a moulded edge and domed cistern-cover. Circa 1710 Although unsigned this barometer is in the manner of John Patrick, an early maker. John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940.
