What is particularly unusual and unique is the decorations found on this piece with dotted and stippled embellishment on the entire exterior. It has an almost optical illusion-like effect and the amount of extra workmanship and detailing is certainly impressive. This pattern extends to the cast spout, handle and even the top finial which presents a uniform and aesthetically pleasing overall design. Each section is further elevated in decorations with a beaded border to accentuate each part. The interior of the teapot remains clean and leak-free, allowing it to also be used practically - a fabulous way to enjoy an opulent afternoon tea by yourself or with guests in an artistic and historically elegant manner.
