The body is adorned with densely carved leaf patterns typical of Kashmiri artistry. The interior reveals three separate hinged compartments designed to hold a total of 48 cigarettes while the exterior is decorated with detailed flora and fauna. 844 g 11 cm tall 11 cm wide 15 cm long Excellent antique condition. Small gaps between border corners, some wear to wood.
