He trained at Camden School of Art, where he was an exceptional student and won a Gold and Silver medal for his work. At the age of twenty-eight (in 1901), Jackson had his first painting exhibited at the Royal Academy. Shortly before this, he began to publish illustrations in *The Sketch*, painted covers for the *Daily Mail Sixpenny Novel* series, and illustrated children's books.
