This beautiful shaped planter has splendid ormolu mounts enclosing two enchanting hand-painted and gilded Sevres porcelain plaques with Bleu Celeste borders, one featuring a charming winged cherub with gilded highlights and the second plaque with a decorative spray of flowers. It has an attractive pierced ormolu gallery, sumptuous ormolu handles and mounts and raised on a plinth base. It comes with its original liner. The craftsmanship and finish are second to none.
