The same chair can be seen in the Kirkland Museum, Denver, USA and has been exhibited there since 2018. The Museum attributes this design to Dr. Christopher Dresser after comparative research with the Dorman Museum and Harry Lyons. "There is no reason whatsoever why a chair should have four legs.
