Unusual Fleur-de-Lys style handle flowing into an elegant stem with small ladle well to the end and pouring spout set to the side. Bears the makers mark for highly regarded and collected Danish silver maker Georg Jensen, along with early London Silver Import marks and guardian stamp (CFH) used between 1904 and 1932.
