Thomas Brigg & Sons, said to have been founded in 1836, were makers of fine quality umbrellas and canes in London. They merged with the London firm of Swaine & Adeney to form Swaine, Adeney, Brigg & Sons Ltd in 1943. Hallmarked: Lion for sterling silver. Leopard's Head for London. Date letter T for 1894. Maker's mark T.J for Thomas Johnson II. Also marked Brigg. Dimensions: Length: 90 cm (35 1/2"). Width: 9.5 cm (3 3/4"). Weight: 254 g.
