The Case The case is in solid very shiny brass and standing 46cm high x 20cm wide with a depth of 17cm it is in very good original condition very shiny and has been very well looked after over the years. All glass panels and doors again are in mint condition. The Dial The dial is in original condition it is convex signed and made of porcelain with the Roman numerals and the clock set off with the original spade hands. The Movement The movement is an eight day time and strike striking the hours and halves on a large sweet bell a real quality movement, which still retains the original key and matching brass pendulum. The movement keeps good time over the eight days; just been serviced and running very strong. Please do not miss...
