It is in very good condition with no damage to any of the stones. The front of the bracelet is fashioned as a buckle that is set with eight agates. The clasp is tight closing and there is a safety chain connecting the ends. There are 8 separate stones in the main strap - a collection of moss agates, montrose agates and jaspers.
