Superb quality heavy grade of selected mahogany which has achieved a wonderful rich period-style colour and patina . In excellent condition with no breaks or repairs. The drop-in seats with old , but serviceable, upholstery , which could be reupholstered at cost price in client's choice of fabric . Possibly by James Hicks of Dublin .
