It is said Exhibited paintings often had elaborate gilt frames as opposed to his local paintings which often had stained oak sometimes with a small gold slip. This would lead me to believe this painting has probably been exhibited at some point. Frederick Golden Short was a New Forest landscape painter in watercolour and oils. Golden Short lived in Lyndhurst, new forest hampshire and exhibited from 1882-1908. He was often seen riding his bicycle around the New Forest with his Windsor and Newton painting box.
