The posterior surface of each pepper incorporates scales and a protruding spine. The head of each silver dragon is embellished with pierced 'pepper' holes. Both the pepper cellars are fitted with screw fit stoppers to the underside of the base. These rare peppers were crafted by the Sheffield silversmiths James Dixon & Son bear hallmarks pertaining to 1848 and 1855. These exceptional and unusual Victorian silver cruets are the finest of their type you could hope to acquire.
