This is a magnificent antique brass bound coromandel Victorian Gothic Revival casket by Parkins and Gotto, 24 & 25 Oxford Street, London, circa 1860 in date. The rectangular box features studded brass bands terminating in fleur de lys appliqués, it opens to reveal a green velvet lining and has it's original working lock and key. Dimensions in cm: Height 13 cm x Width 31 cm x Depth 22 cm Dimensions in inches: Height 5 inches x Width 1 foot x Depth 9 inches Parkins and Gotto William Parkins and Henry Jenkin Gotto formed the company of Parkins & Gotto principally as stationers but they quickly grew to sell a large variety of goods. They offered a wide range of items from dressing cases and luggage to sporting goods and toys. The 1852 London Directory lists them at 2 Hanway St. and 25 Oxford St. Although the 1846 Directory doesn't list them, their free Almanack & Stationery catalogue of 1853 advertised that it was in its 8th year of publication dating the start of the company at to as early as 1845. In 1860 The Society of Arts awarded them a silver medal.

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
