The polychrome central motif on the saucer and cup feature groups of various colourful exotic birds and surrounding the birds are an array of insects. Both items feature a scalloped rim and a gilded decorative border. Marked on the back with the Meissen mark of blue crossed swords. 384 g cup - 7 cm tall, 10 cm top diameter, 11 cm handle to rim, 4.5 cm bottom diameter saucer - 4 cm tall, 15 cm top diameter, 5 cm base diameter. Saucer in very good antique condition; some wear to gilt appropriate to age. Cup has been professionally restored.
