Fascinating 5-draw type, drawing from a usefully compact length of 29cm (11.5") Fully drawn with the sun shade extended, the length is over 3' (43.75") Clear, bright objective lens with a generous diameter of 60mm (2.25") The flared eyepiece finished with concentric ring turning. Engraved to the penultimate barrel for Broadhurst, Clarkson & Co of London Dealer engraving to the opposite side for H Salanson & Co of Bristol and Cardiff Focus tube engraved with numerals from 30 through to 60 in order of tens.
