The lugs have a slight chamfering to the edges. Original Longines winding crown. The watch bears the 'fish in seaweed' insignia of the Conquest line, in good condition. This watch bears the reference 9004 5. The watch is powered by a 19 jewel caliber 19 ASD Longines mechanism. The 10million serial numbers date the watch to 1957.
