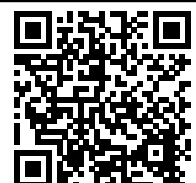
This exquisite and rare 19th Century French *Palais Royal egg-shaped sewing etui is carved in iridescent mother of pearl with a gilt metal mount and legs. It opens to reveal the original blue velvet pad with paper loops and fitted with the complete and original set of miniature tools. *Palais Royal is a term used to describe, not a single manufacturer, but to a name given to a small area around the Royal Palace that specialized in producing small elaborate works of art and gifts in the 18th and 19th centuries.
