Description

This charming mid-19th-century oil painting by Danish artist Peter Ølsted (1824-1887) depicts a picturesque view of Mølledammen, Lyngby, with a fisherman and church beyond. Ølsted produced tranquil landscapes with carefully observed views across abundant pastures and idyllic rural villages. His style was entirely traditional and influenced by the Danish Golden Age. Broad graduated skies often dominate compositions with linear horizons dotted with precise architecture. This romantic vision of the Danish countryside was popular with a range of buyers including Princess Caroline and Prince Georg. Like many, they were drawn to his gentle vision of a land they treasured. Here, in this work from around 1860, he's captured the Mølledammen (mill pond) at Lyngby, north of Copenhagen. The church, built in the Romanesque style, dates to the 12th century and cuts an imposing figure as it rises above the trees.
