H: 27 cm (10 5/8") W: 12 cm (4 3/4") D: 9 cm (3 9/16") Blue John is a rare Crystalline gemstone marble, unique to a single mine at Castleton, Derbyshire and much admired in the 18th century, as it is today by discerning collectors.
