Description

A large and playful oil painting of an artists studio with artist and sitter by Spanish artist Eduardo Sanchez Sola (1869 -1949). Sánchez Solá is linked to the school of Granada although he was born in Madrid on 25 June 1869. A student at the Special School of Painting, Sculpture and Engraving and of the painters Alejandro Ferrant Fischermans and the more modest Luis Taberner Montalvo (in his decorative art works submitted to the National Exhibitions of Fine Arts), he himself became a teacher at the Granada School of Arts and Crafts. He is described as a painter of genre scenes, portraits and animals. As for genre scenes, Sánchez Solá gained a reputation as "the painter of altar boys". Other genre scenes are Playtime (oil on canvas, Bonhams, 23/03/2004, lot no. 92), and Mischief (oil on canvas, 94.6 x 121.9 cm, signed, Waddington's, auction 16/06/2003, lot. no. 353), a humorous work in which one of the figures in a playful group of girls in the painter's studio paints a moustache on the portrait of one of them. We suspect our painting features the same painter with his moustache gazing into the eyes of his beautiful sitter. A superb example, measuring 110 cm x 85 cm ...
