Very rare antique Victorian Copeland coloured Parian Ware figure of "Adversity", by Owen Hale. The large biscuit porcelain sculpture is hand-painted in subdued powder blue and pink palette with delicate floral bouquets to the dress and gilt accents. The figure depicts a poorly dressed girl in an ill-fitting dress, carrying a basket of wilting flowers. The statue rests on a marbelised base that is impressed with "COPELAND" to reverse and "ADVERSITY" to the front. Sculpted by Owen Hale, dating to c. 1870. Height 50 cm Base dimensions 14.6 x 14.6 x cm Weight 2832 g Condition: Right arm restored from above the elbow to the finger tips; hairline crack to base around hem of dress.
