These chimney pots not only added aesthetic appeal but also improved flue draft, especially important for coal-burning fires common at the time. They were typically made of terracotta or iron and could be quite tall, with some reaching 4 1/2 feet. Chimney pots with Gothic arch details are a distinctive architectural element from the 19th century and is indicative of the Gothic Revival style, which was popular in the latter half of the 19th century.
