Technical Description An exceptionally rare example of an 18th century Liege wine glass which dates to c1725. It has a waisted round funnel bowl with a very unusual raised square nut moulding. Sits on a clear stem with shoulder and basal knops above a conical folded foot. A superb example, probably made at the Nizet glasshouse in Belgium. **Date & Origin** Belgium, c1725 **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 12.2cm Rim diameter: 6cm Foot diameter: 6cm **Comments** The glass comes from the Ira Shrager collection and was last on the market in 2016. No other examples of this form as been seen since that time.

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
