Sits on a wrythen stem with inverted baluster and basal knops above a conical folded foot. A superb example, probably made at the Nizet glasshouse in Belgium. **Date & Origin** Belgium, c1725 **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 11.4cm Rim diameter: 6.7cm Foot diameter: 7cm **Comments** The glass comes from the Ira Shrager collection and was last on the market in 2017. No other examples of this form as been seen since that time.
