The underside marked with painted Coalport stamp which was used after 1920 and painted pattern number 5331/B in puce. Additional mark of Stonier & Co., of Liverpool, 78 St. Lord Street. Stonier & Co supplied the British shipping company White Star Line, of the Titanic fame. This rare plate would make a wonderful addition to a collection of Coalport china or look great on its own as a cabinet plate. A fantastic antique find in unusually good condition.
