Description This fine antique Irish mahogany serving table, made circa 1910 in the manner of James Hicks of Dublin, is a superb example of early 20th-century craftsmanship inspired by the George II period (1727–1760). Constructed from mahogany and pine, the table features a moulded rectangular top above a finely carved frieze decorated with foliate swags and a bold central mask carving — a hallmark of Irish furniture design. The piece stands on elegantly carved cabriole legs with shell motifs terminating in classic ball-and-claw feet, echoing the robust yet graceful aesthetic of 18th-century Dublin furniture. The rich, warm patina of the mahogany enhances the depth and beauty of the carving, making this table as decorative as it is functional. Whether used as a console, serving, or side table, this piece embodies the refined grandeur of Georgian taste and the craftsmanship for which Irish furniture makers are celebrated.
