Flemish, late 16th century/ 17th century - Follower of Ambrious Benson Oil on Oak Panel: Virgin and Infant in a Rose Garden Landscape Benson was born in Lombardy but moved to Bruges in the southern Netherlands after spending some time in Spain. He arrived in Bruges in 1518, and by the following year, he had gained entry into the local guild of painters as an independent master. Benson was already a successful painter of portraits and altarpieces prior to his arrival, but in Bruges, he worked for a short time in the studio of Gerard David. His paintings owe much to David's style but also reflect the art of his native Lombardy and the painters who worked there, such as Leonardo.
