Beautiful study of a lady reading at a table. The oil on canvas is signed by the Belgium artist Victor van Dyck (1862 - 1949) and is mounted in an attractive more recent frame and slip. The artist's attention to detail in this work is superb, the dress and the rug covering the table in particular. There is also a magnificent red vase in the background. The painting has been relined and cleaned. It dates from the late 19th century. Van Dyck trained at the academies of Brussels (1877-1884) and Antwerp, he worked in Brussels before becoming a teacher at the Academy of his hometown in 1913. He was generally a painter of historical and religious subjects and portraits.
