On the underside is a blue crossed sword, a red "40" and the inscriptions "C73" (model number) and "127" Mid-19th Century, possibly older, 1st choice. The figurine is finely modelled and painted with underglaze paint, partially gilded Condition: unfortunately, the rose in the right hand is missing.
