The box opening to form a writing slope with brass trimmed edges to match the exterior and original fitments. The writing surface with original tooled red leather, the lids on each side opening with storage compartments below; the deeper side with three secret drawers behind a spring release panel. Removable pen tray to the front with two original silver plated top travelling ink wells set to either side. Bramah lock bearing the makers name Sampson Mordan to the front edge.
