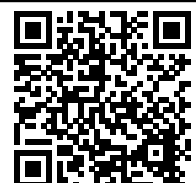
This is a decorative antique English provincial Georgian oak side table, also known as an "Estate table", with two drawers, circa 1810, displaying a rich dark oak colour, in good condition. Such a table would have been made for use on a country estate, used for office paperwork and collecting land rent from tenants. This particular table came from a country house in Staffordshire. The table comprises a solid two-plank oak top, above two working drawers, with a cock-beaded fronts. The oak-lined drawers are constructed with hand-dovetail joints and incorporate later Georgian oval brass handles and backplates. The drawer runs smoothly and closes f...
