Description

A very good example of a Campaign Butlers Tray Table from the late 19th Century. Crafted in a lovely rich mahogany which now has a lovely time worn patina. Having its original brass snap-hinges and stand with canvas webbing. Stamped to tray and stand A & N C.S.L (Army and Navy Co-operative Society Ltd). A functional tray table with all the hinges in good working order so the sides can be laid flat allowing it to be used as an occasional table if so wished. Measurements given are with the sides closed up. The Army & Navy Co-operative Society Ltd. was incorporated on 15 September 1871, being formed by a group of army and navy officers. The aim of the was to supply goods to its members at the lowest remunerative rates. The society leased part of a distillery premises in Victoria Street, London which was owned by Vickers & Co. By 1876, the business had again outgrown its premises. They leased more of the distillery from Vickers, closed their warehouse in Johnson Place moving to a new location at Ranelagh Road in Pimlico. The business was now offering a banking department to its members, and had negotiated an option on the site as part of the lease deal at Victoria Street. T...
