The phrenology head sat above with grey wording and divisions detailing the area of the brain and brain function. Fredrick Bridges was a renowned English phrenologist and was author of the book 'Phrenology Made Practical' - the book was printed in several editions and was hugely popular. This rare phrenology head presented in superb undamaged condition with no restoration, small manufacturers glaze fault to the front corner. Measures 5.5" high x 2.75" wide x 3.25" deep.
