A very fine example made from a good heavy gauge of English sterling silver weighing a hefty 2.88 troy ounces or 89.7 grams. The body is beautifully decorated with all-over hand engraving with a central large cartouche to the lid which could be engraved by your silversmith should you desire. The box is a squeeze action type, opened by squeezing the sides for the lid to pop open, the lid works perfectly and snaps shut. The interior is beautifully gold washed or gilded. There are good clear hallmarks for Birmingham 1893, so a true Victorian example. The makers initials are also present for the well renowned and highly prized George Unite.
