The underside of the box is ornamented with engine turned decoration incorporating a vacant rectangular cartouche. Both the base and cover are embellished with applied scrolling leaf decorated borders. The hinged silver gilt vinaigrette cover allows access to the original hinged pierced decorated silver gilt grille. This antique box retains the original gilding to the interior and exterior surfaces.
