Remarkably, these legs have managed to retain much of their original turned feet, a rare find that indicates the stool's well-preserved state through the centuries. Overall, this joint stool is not only a functional piece of furniture but also a collector's item that captures the essence of 17th century English aesthetics and the high level of artisanship of the time.
