They were originally based in Silver Street, moving to Kensington Church Street in 1916. A. J Rowley has signed this work, other notable designers for the firm include Frank Brangwyn and W. A Chase. Original condition with losses to the gesso as per images. The crest looks original and was possibly a specific request from the original client, but it is a little awkward and could be easily removed if required!
