The fine quality single fusee, 8 day movement with shouldered plates and very fine gear work. Anchor escapement with passing strike on the hour and half hour on a curled gong. Fine blued steel spade hands. The finely figured mahogany case with original carved ears and typical Condliff octagonal surround, inlaid with ebony and boxwood stringing. Cast brass bezel with access to the case from two side doors and lower door to the curved base. 2 year mechanical guarantee.
