The necks have three engraved rings with bands of prismatic cuts. The main bodies have unusual hanging fruiting vines with grapes. Polished pontils to the base. Excellent examples with unusual engravings which are not normally presented in this style. **Date & Origin** England or Bohemia, c1860. **Period of Victoria.** **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration, clean and clear. The corks have dried and there is some loss to the base of the corks as shown. **Dimensions** Height: 32.5cm (includes stopper) Diameter: 8cm.
