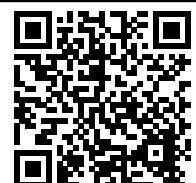

The lid and base have engine turned engraving and there is a shaped cartouche to the top, containing the original owner's initials. The sides are scalloped and have stylised engraving and the lid has a cast thumb grip for opening. Inside the vinaigrette lid is a poignant engraved message "With Aunt Fannie's dying love."
