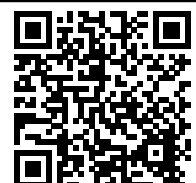
Description

The vessel is anchored just outside The Grand Harbour, known as the Port of Valletta, which is a natural harbour on the island of Malta. ABOUT THE ARTIST James Hardy III was a British painter who was born in 1937. His works are well known in the art market and are very desirable and an excellent investment. The painting is very similar in manner to works by Salvatore Colacicco and demonstrates an excellent standard of detail and accuracy in the way the vessel is painted, having plenty of natural daylight and brightness conveyed within the scene. His paintings are similar in manner to works by James Hardy and are selling today for considerable sums ranging from £3000- £5000 and higher for the largest examples involving more time and effort to paint. Salvatore Colacicco's style of painting was very reminiscent of marine artists during the 19th century and his works have an obvious Italian feel as does the example we offer.
