Capped with a hinged sterling top decorated with an ornate Art Nouveau motif. The design was registered to James Macintyre's Washington China Works in Burslem. A lot of similar bottles were produced in cooperation between Macintyre and Sampson Mordan, with Mordan providing silver mounts for these wonderful perfume bottles.
