This high quality hot cast solid bronze pair was produced using the traditional "lost wax" process, otherwise known as the "cire perdue" method. Lost Wax Method sometimes called by the French name of cire perdue or the Latin, cera perduto is the process by which a bronze or brass is cast from an artists sculpture.
