Fitted on a Stainless steel Bonklip strap. Diameter 32.5mm excluding crown. One other illustrated example is shown in Military Timepieces by Z M Wesolowski, issue no A12696, also bearing the PAF mark, but the author referring that particular example to the Polish Air Force. It is today now considered that the PAF stands for the Pakistan Airforce which was created and equipped by the British Royal Airforce as part of the creation and partitioning of India and Pakistan in 1946-1947.
